The SILVER SAGE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY, being the owners and operators of the Silver Sage Community Corral and the Kinsmen & UFA Barns will be referred to by "S.S.C.C."

The undersigned releases the S.S.C.C. its agents, its directors, and employees from any rights, claims, demands, damages, causes of action and costs of whatever kind or nature, including any consequential loss or damage that the undersigned may have as a result of the undersigned's use of the facility and on the lands and premises owned and operated by the SILVER SAGE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY and the undersigned gives up any right of action against the aforesaid party which may arise by reason of contract, negligence, breach of duty or in any other manner whatsoever.

RULES OF BOARDING:

- 1. Stall rental rate is (all prices include GST) \$125 outdoor stall, \$200 for 2 horses in one pen; \$125 indoor stall/horse; \$175 indoor stall with turn out pen per month / horse (does not include shavings). \$125 deposit will be required upon arrival. The deposit will be returned once horse leaves premises and area is cleaned up to satisfaction of manager.
- 2. Board is due the beginning on each month. If coming in part way through a month, please contact the office for a pro-rated fee.
- 3. Payments can be made by etransfer to <u>silversageagsociety@hotmail.com</u> (should show as auto deposit and please note in comments what payment is for) or by cash or cheque left in an envelope in the downstairs bar drop box. Please put in the slot, not the black file folder, and note on envelope what payment is for. Contact office for receipts.
- 4. All horses must be in and remain in good health before being brought onto the premises.
- 5. Proper care of animal, including feed, water and shavings is the responsibility of the horse owner and provision of the same will be strictly enforced by the S.S.C.C. Lack of proper care will result in eviction.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the renter to keep stall/pen and area around of the stall/pen clean.
- 7. Hay must be stored in designated areas only.
- 8. Area in front of stall and hay storage must be kept clean at all times and all waste to be disposed of to designated area.
- 7. Stallions may only be stalled on a discretionary basis, according to approval of the Board of Directors of the S.S.C.C. Stallions will not be turned out.

- 8. Cattle pens and livestock handling pens (South of the Silver Sage Community Corral) will not be used as turn out pens by monthly stall boarders of the Barns.
- 9. Any complaints, problems or suggestions must be taken in writing to the Board of Directors of the S.S.C.C.
- 10. Use of the riding and wash bay facilities requires a membership, drop-in fee per use or a monthly fee due with board. Contact office to purchase.
- 11. All pricing is subject to change with thirty (30) days notice.

By signing this Release, I will be FOREVER PRECLUDED FROM SUING OR OTHERWISE CLAIMING AGAINST S.S.C.C., its agents, directors, and employees for any loss or damage or injury or death that I or my animal may sustain while engaged in any activities, attending at, or using any facilities owned or operated by the S.S.C.C., whether or not such loss or injury is caused by negligence or fault of S.S.C.C., its agents, directors, and employees.

I understand that the S.S.C.C. will not permit me to attend at or to use its facilities now or in the future unless I sign this release.

This release is binding on myself, my heirs, executors, administrator, personal representatives and assigns.
