STALL RENTAL AGREEMENT & RELEASE FORM

The SILVER SAGE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY, being the owners and operators of the Silver Sage Community Corral and the Kin Barn will be referred to by "S.S.C.C."

The undersigned releases the S.S.C.C. its agents, its directors, and employees from any rights, claims, demands, damages, causes of action and costs of whatever kind or nature, including any consequential loss or damage that the undersigned may have as a result of the undersigned's use of the facility and on the lands and premises owned and operated by the SILVER SAGE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY and the undersigned gives up any right of action against the aforesaid party which may arise by reason of contract, negligence, breach of duty or in any other manner whatsoever.

RULES OF BOARDING:

1. Stall rental rate is (all prices are G.S.T.included) \$75.00 outdoor stall, \$115 for 2 horses in one pen. \$100 indoor stall. \$120 indoor stall with turn out pen per month
2. All horses must have been currently vaccinated before being brought onto the premises. Proof of vaccination must be supplied before bringing animal onto premises of the Barns.
3. Proper care of animal, including feed, water and shavings is the responsibility of the horse owner and provision of the same will be strictly enforced by the S.S.C.C. Lack of proper care will result in eviction.
4. It is the responsibility of the renter to keep stall and area in front of the stall clean. .
5. Hay must be stored in designated areas only; approximately 15 bales of hay may be stored at one time - enough hay to feed one horse for a month. This may change according to availability of space.
6. Area in front of stall and hay storage must be kept clean at all times and all waste to be disposed of to designated area.
7. Stallions may only be stalled on a discretionary basis, according to approval of the Board of Directors of the S.S.C.C. Stallions will not be turned out.
8. Cattle pens and livestock handling pens (South of the Silver Sage Community Corral) will not be used as turn out pens by monthly stall boarders of the Barns.
9. Any complaints, problems or suggestions must be taken in writing to the Board of Directors of the S.S.C.C. Any discussion that pertains to the Board of Directors or the Manager of the Silver Sage Community Corral, that is not given first hand from the
